Description : Set of Gallic iron relics: sword in its scabbard; iron and heel of a spear; three fibulae (brooches), two of which are linked by a chain; belt ring with a button; umbo of a finned shield. The umbo is a domed or conical piece of iron or bronze in the middle of a shield, to protect the hand.
