**Période chronologique** Protohistory [- 2200 / - 50] → Iron Age [- 800/ - 50] → 1st Iron Age [- 800/ - 480]

**Dimensions** L. 6.4 cm

**Description** : Bronze fibula of the Dux type, with internal cord and spring with two times three coils. This second fibula is smaller than the previous one. Its oval arch is flattened. It is decorated in its center with five pointed circles arranged in a rhombus and a group of four rhombuses also occulted, on either side of the previous motif. The foot ends with a globular bead topped by a beak.
